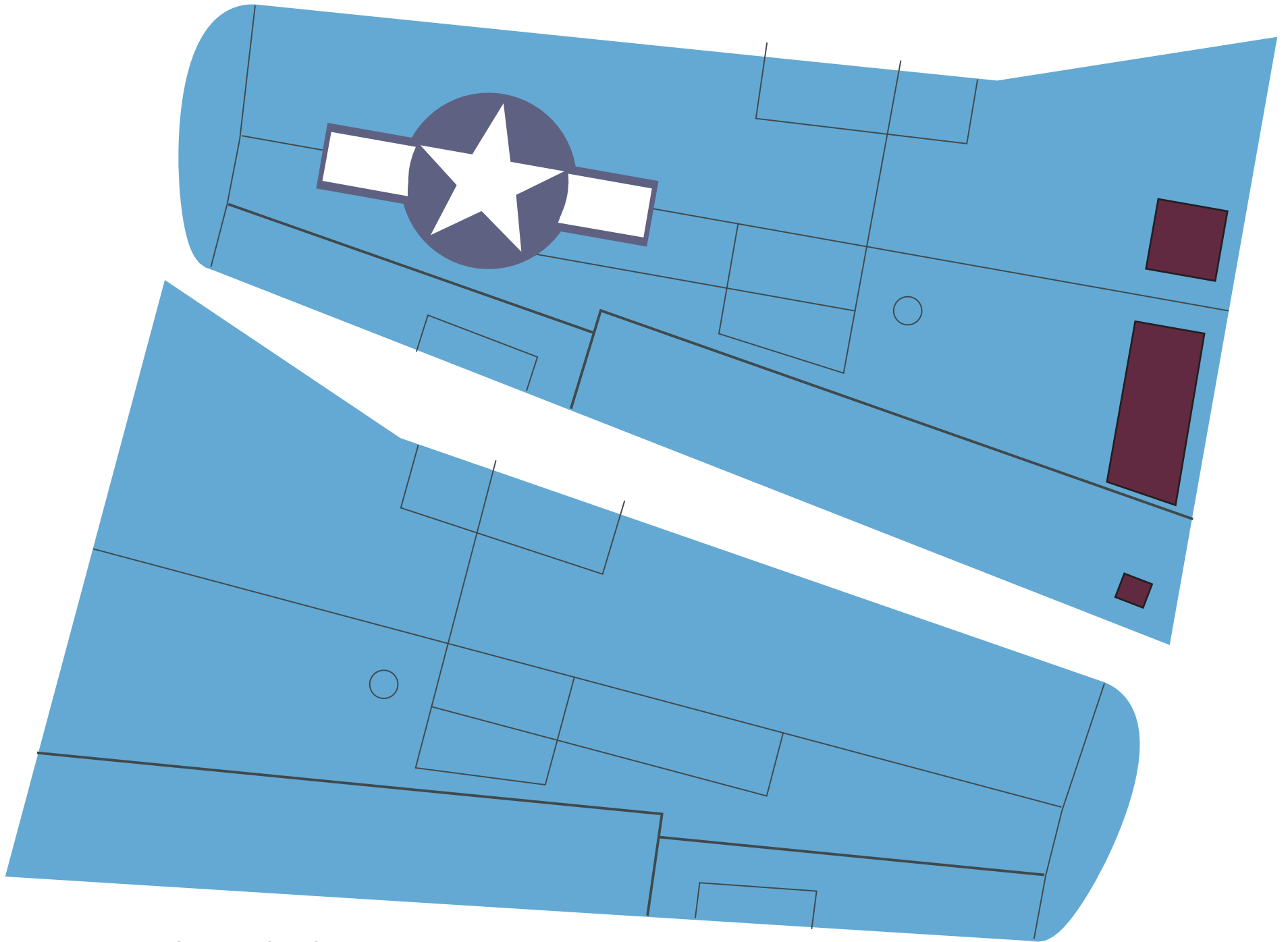
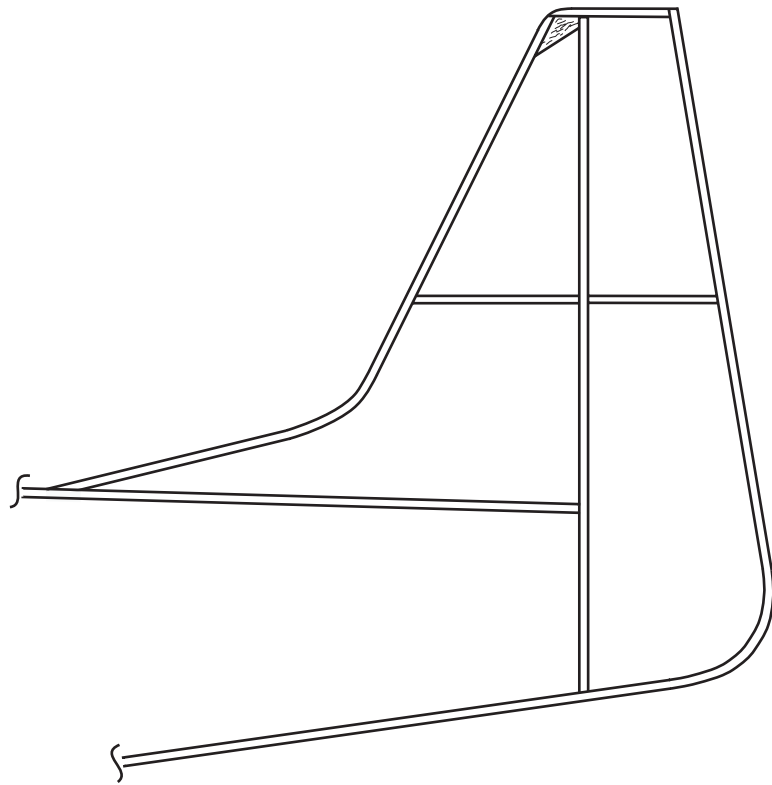


EAA P-51 Covering - Sheet 1 of 3

This P-51D is part of the EAA AirVenture Museum Collection in Oshkosh, WI. Acquired by the EAA in 1977, it was often flown by EAA Founder and Chairman of the board Paul Poberezny until it was retired in 2003. Artwork for Paul Bradley's P-51D profile plan by Alden and H.G. Frautschy, Oshkosh, Wisconsin. Please note the following change to the plans: additional height to the vertical fin. See additional sheet for revised structure outlines. To be perfectly to outline scale, we should have also changed the outline of the canopy, but we don't care for the humpback look of the two-place cockpit, so we left it as it was. Feel free to modify the outline if you feel it is necessary.
